Aware of the criminal consequences provided in case of false statements,

declares

pursuant to art. 46 of d.p.r. 445/2000:

1. To be the owner/holder, and, in any case, responsible for the animal dog cat breed _____ size _____
2. That all mandatory legal requirements regarding registration, notifications, vaccinations, and, where applicable, tattoo and/or microchip have been fulfilled for the aforementioned animal.
3. To have read, understood and fully accepted the contents of Mayor's Ordinance of the Municipality of Rosolina and the Village Regulations (always available for viewing at the reception), as well as all other relevant laws regarding pets.
4. To be aware that animals must always be kept on a leash no longer than 1.5 m, and that the owner/handler must carry a muzzle to be applied in case of risk to the safety of people or animals, as provided by the Ministry of Health Ordinance of 06/08/2013 and, in any case, always for animals with aggressive character, as provided by the facility regulations.
5. To be aware of the prohibition for animals to access the beach except in the designated area, well indicated on-site by special signs.
6. To be aware that there in that beach area where animals are allowed there are no pre-assigned positions on the aforesaid stretch of beach and that therefore, each Guest may position themselves freely but taking into consideration the obligation to prevent the animal from causing any disturbance or reaching neighbors.
7. To be aware of the existence, in the aforesaid stretch of beach, of a place for watering and refreshing dogs, where however it is forbidden to use detergents of any kind.
8. To be aware of the obligation to remove any solid waste using the appropriate hygienic bags and to deposit them in the appropriate waste container and to disperse any liquid excrements by washing them with plenty of sea water.
9. To guarantee supervision of the animal and to assume full responsibility, with obligation to indemnify Rosapineta Camping Village for any damage or injury, to anyone caused by the dog, both inside the Village and on the beach. The animal cannot be left unattended and free to roam and must be constantly looked after by the handler, who will have to ensure that prolonged barking and excessively lively behavior are avoided, under penalty of removal at the sole discretion of the Management and/or the competent authorities.
10. To have read, understood, and accepted the main obligations (summarized below) and the guidelines established by the competent authorities for the protection of dogs' health and the safety of other users of the beach, in compliance with the current Municipal Ordinance:
 - Obligation of valid health booklet.
 - Obligation of regularity of vaccination prophylaxis against the main infectious diseases (distemper, leptospirosis and parvoviruses). Anti-rabies vaccination for dogs coming from abroad.
 - Banned to bring dogs on the beach suffering from cardiovascular diseases.
 - Must provide water reserve and bowl.
 - Must provide paddle and bags for manure collection.
 - Animals must be kept on a leash no longer than 1.5 m and wear a flea collar.
 - Obligation to supervise the animal in order to avoid prolonged barking and excessively lively behavior.
 - A sun umbrella is required for prolonged stays.
 - Must carry a rigid or soft muzzle to be used in case of risk to the safety of people or animals.
 - Retention of access to the beach for animals in heat and animals of aggressive nature.

The non-compliance with the requirements and obligations hereby in accordance with these guidelines shall result in the application of penalties, including fines provided for by law. Civil and criminal responsibility for damages to people/things is exclusively the owner/holder of the animal.
